Could you spot the signs?

As a business you may notice behaviour involving children which seems odd or unexplained.

Signs of child sexual exploitation on your premises could range from young people having older 'boyfriends' or dressing older than their age. They can be manipulated or forced into taking part in a sexual act, either as part of a seemingly consensual relationship, or in return for attention, gifts, money, alcohol, drugs or somewhere to stay.

Child protection is everyone's responsibility

Safeguarding Children Board

The Red Book contains:

Refusals logs (red)

To record every time the sale of alcohol is refused and why.

Patrol logs (black)

To record any instance of substance misuse or dealing, anti-social behaviour, underage drinking or lack of parent/carer supervision of children.

Incident logs (orange)

To record incidents where a child or young person is noticed to be vulnerable.

If you have concerns, you may be unsure about whether you should be worried, but it is important that you don't keep any concerns to yourself.

What to do if you have concerns

Keep records and contact

Police

Call 101 for non-emergencies and quote Operation Makesafe or ask for the Child Sexual Exploitation team.

Call 999 if you are concerned that a child is in immediate danger.
