Would you recognise if a child or young person was being sexually exploited?



If you have concerns about child sexual exploitation, you may be unsure about whether you should be worried, but it is important that you don't keep any concerns to yourself.

# What to do if you have concerns

#### Police

Call 101 for non-emergencies and quote Operation Makesafe or ask for the Child Sexual Exploitation team.

Call 999 if you are concerned that a child is in immediate danger.
