


LIQUID LOGIC

MYTH BUSTER



Liquid Logic is a complex and fully functional system, and we all know it can prove to be difficult for practitioners to fully understand its intricacies. Since its adoption we have seen it develop considerably, but our understanding of it has not always kept up.

We have become aware of some of the more common misconceptions surrounding its use and have decided to set the record straight.

YOU CAN'T REOPEN AN EARLY HELP ASSESSMENT ONCE IT'S BEEN FINALISED



Not true. You can finalise your assessment at any point. In fact you have to in order to write up the TAF outcomes. You then restart your assessment to add more to it. You need to restart your assessment when you wish to add further assessment information.

YOU CAN CONSOLIDATE SOMEONE INTO THE PATHWAY AT THE CLICK OF A BUTTON



False - you have to take them right through the pathway from contact. Also, you cannot do more than one person at a time as the system glitches

EXTERNAL PARTNERS CAN ACCESS THE SOCIAL CARE MODULE



Not true - they can only access EHM

EXTERNAL PARTNERS CAN SEE CASE NOTES



False - externals have access to the pathway and forms but not case notes

EXTERNAL PARTNERS CAN EDIT WORK ON THE SYSTEM



Not true - they have read-only access

INTERNALS CAN ONLY ACCESS LL WHEN ON THE NETWORK SYSTEM



False - you can access it via any internet access but you will not be able to access SC module

PRACTITIONERS ARE EXPECTED TO HAVE A COMPLETE ASSESSMENT BEFORE THE FIRST TAF



Not true - practitioners are expected to have gathered and assessed what information they have at that stage and then to complete a more thorough assessment after the first TAF
