Specialist domestic and sexual abuse provision in Leicester from April 2022

Leicester City Council funds a range of specialist support services for those affected by domestic abuse and sexual violence. These services are expanding in April 2022. The new range of support provision is intended to make the most of local funding. The provision was shaped by engagement sessions with those who had used the existing services, public consultation, and data from the past five years.

The main aim is to improve access and outcomes.

Further services will be funded around the provision of safe accommodation, and these will develop in line with local need.

What stays the same

The local helpline number, **0808 80 200 28**, freephone and hidden from bills, will remain.

The existing providers, with decades of experience of delivering specialist domestic and sexual violence services, remain.

What changes

The consortium 'UAVA'; United Against Violence and Abuse, will end, but partnership work continues and will be supported through the new Leicester Domestic Abuse Locality Partnership Board established as part of the new statutory duties introduced in the 2021 Domestic Abuse Act.

The scrutiny and reference group, made up of people who have accessed specialist services, contributes to improving local responses to domestic abuse and sexual violence, and will be a key part of the Locality Partnership Board.
